Overall Responsibility:

To a) disassemble the engine in it's entirety to prepare it to be cleaned and inspected, once it has been received into the system and b) clean the engine using a variety of cleaning methods to prepare it to be inspected.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Disassembling aircraft engines once they arrive at Aerotec
- Cleaning the disassembled engine parts using a variety of cleaning processes based on material, manufacturer, etc.
- Documenting each disassembly using company forms
- Tagging and sorting parts
- Maintaining cleanliness throughout the cleaning/teardown department
- Opportunity to be involved in continuous improvement programs

Skills Required:

- Ability to use a computer to enter information
- Ability to manage multiple tasks simultaneously
- Ability to use various hand tools
- Capable of working both independently and with others (highly collaborative work environment)
- Willingness to clean engines from various substances including oil, grease, paint, etc.
- Well organized

Reporting/Supervisory Requirements:

- Reports to operations manager
- Required to supervise co-op students when they are assigned to cleaning/teardown

Working Conditions:

- Use of hand tools
- Minimal use of technology
- Required to work at Aerotec's sole location
- Required to work during usual business hours (8am – 5pm) unless stated/requested otherwise
